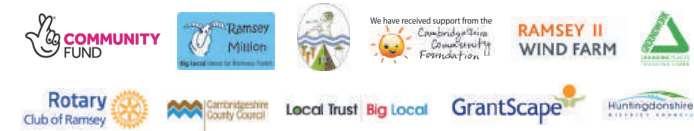

RAMSEY Crunch

CRUNCH Youth Project is for 11 to 16 year olds. We meet weekly during term-time.

We also hold activities during school holidays and organize trips out on a regular basis. Favourites include: Gauntlet Auto Project, Cinema, Bowling, Ice Skating and SnoZone.



The Dog's Meet

The Dog's Meet is a community café where people can bring their dogs to a friendly, informal space.

Some attend to socialise their dogs, others like the relaxed atmosphere and meeting other people. You don't need to have a dog to attend - everyone is welcome.



Job Search

Job Search provides a support and training service right here in Ramsey.

It includes access to employment and volunteering opportunities, employability courses, CV and application writing and information about other relevant services.



Ramsey Timebank

The timebank is about people doing things together and for each other.

The currency of the timebank is time and everybody's hour has the same value. The more people join, the more services or 'exchanges' Ramsey Timebank can offer.



Phoenix

RNTs innovative training programme is based around the interests/hobbies of residents. It helps people learn new skills and builds confidence and, for those who are looking for work, it enhances employability. RNT recognises the need for people to come together to reduce the incidents of isolation and loneliness. Therefore, we also run leisure workshops that are open to everyone.



SPARKS

SPARKS is a social club for adults with additional needs.

SPARKS offers activities such as crafts, games, outings, musical and physical activities.

At SPARKS you can make new friends, but most of all SPARKS is fun!



COMMUNITY MARKET

Ramsey Community Market has pitches available Thursdays and Saturdays on the Great Whyte.

Specialty markets and car boot sales also run throughout the year.

Pitches are available for traders and community groups/charities on a one-off or long-term basis.
